Public Notice: Invitation to Bid

Brief description of the desired items or services:

The White River Conservation District (WRCD) is accepting sealed bids for a 374-acre Pinyon and Juniper mastication project on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land approximately 17 miles southwest of Meeker, CO as part of a Coordinated Resource Management Plan (CRMP).

A pre-bid conference is NOT required, but you are encouraged to reach out to the Project Manager early enough that your bid can be received (sealed, hard-copy) by the WRCD by the deadline.

Where/how to submit the completed bid; Deadline for submitting bids:

Sealed bids must be received (not post-marked by deadline date or emailed) by the **WRCD office by no later than 4:00 p.m. MST on Monday, July 15, 2024.**

Time, date, and location of bid opening

Sealed bids will be opened, publicly at the Conservation Districts' office at 4:00 p.m. MST on July 15, 2024. Bids are normally awarded within 2 to 3 weeks of the closing date.

Purpose: *To make available technical, financial, and educational resources, whatever their source, and focus or coordinate them so that they meet the needs of the local land manager with conservation of soil, water, and related natural resources.*

Award criteria

Applicants for this contract will need to submit:

1. Completed bid sheet which includes price per acre as well as total cost of the project.
2. Technical Capability and Experience - include a description of your technical approach and expected timeframe to complete the project, equipment, supervision and personnel.
3. Two past performance reports showing similar work, in a similar environment, of a similar scale that has been completed before the associated performance evaluations. Reports shall be for projects completed in the last three years. WRCD may, at its discretion, base past performance, past knowledge and previous experience with the contractor, supply or service being provided, customer survey or other reasonable basis.
4. Contact information for two references from entities where similar work, in a similar environment, of a similar scale was completed.

Application Evaluation: While minimal cost of services/project is important, WRCD is not required to accept the low bid.
